#### **Steroid refractory giant cell arteritis with bilateral ...**

Giant cell arteritis is the most common primary systemic vasculitis in adults aged  $\geq 50$  years and peaks in the eighth decade of life Common symptoms include headache, scalp tenderness and jaw claudication Elevated acute phase reactants (erythrocyte sedimentation rate and C-reactive protein) are present in >90% of patients Visual loss is a

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associated granulomatous vasculitis if the clinical features are typical Perinuclear ANCA positivity raises the possibility of Churg-Strauss syndrome or microscopic poly-angiitis Imaging findings of pulmonary vasculitis are diverse and often poorly specific The use of a pattern-based approach to the imaging findings may help narrow the
